Owners must follow the pet stroll rules. Please remember, good dogs must meet all guidelines and maintain current vaccinations (Rabies, Distemper and Parvo Virus).

- · Costumes are encouraged, but not mandatory.
- · Be creative, and If you do dress up please keep your dogs safety and comfort in mind
- Floats should be no longer than 4' long
- · No motorized vehicles allowed
- · Children accompanying a dog's owner must be supervised to walk a good dog in the stroll
- Dogs must remain on leash or safely secured in a float at all times and all owners must remain with their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs and female dogs in heat are not allowed.
- · Owners must immediately remove dogs from the event at the first sign of aggressive behavior
- · Please be courteous to others
- · Owners must remove and dispose of waste properly
- While small bite-sized training treats are permitted food in bowls, long-lasting chews, or glass containers are not allowed
- · Dogs must be vaccinated for Rabies, Distemper and Parvo Virus
- · Owners are liable for any injury or damage caused by their dog and are fully responsible for their dog's actions
